

It's been an interesting fall. We have been working our way through Luke's Gospel to glean what we can from Jesus' politics. The reason is obvious. Politics are bombarding us as an im-



portant election looms just a few days away. One thing I hope that you have heard throughout the series is that our vote is only one small part of our politics. Jesus gives us an imagination for how to engage our polis (our city/state/nation) for the benefit of those who are most vulnerable. And we don't have to wait four more years to do it!

If anything, I hope this campaign cycle has highlighted for us how important it is to have Christians engaged in the life of the polis—not to make life easier for us, but to model how to listen well, hold different ideas and values in creative tension, and amplify the voices of the most vulnerable that often get silenced in all the debate. This is our work, and it is urgent work. We, the Church, cannot keep getting lost in little debates over internal matters. The world needs light and love and agents of peace cultivating God's Jubilee Vision.

Advent takes us in a bit of a different direction. Rather than looking mostly at big picture stuff and how the Church and Polis relate, we are going to look at some of the very personal realities of our lives, seeking



to connect with God in deep and transformative ways.

The series is called "The Gift," but the gifts we look at each week might surprise you. I hope you will join in the powerful community practices of prayer and song, as well as lighting the Advent candles and asking God to come and be "God-with-Us."

Lastly, we will be talking about finances a bit this month with a Stewardship Sunday, 2nd Mile letters, and Pledge Cards. We hope that the value this church brings to you and to our neighborhood translates into a generous sharing of our resources together. This is how the church works.
