I have a friend who has planted a church in Davenport, IA. They call themselves "A Community of Transformation" where people are moving "from greed toward generosity, from violence toward peacemaking, from isolation toward neighborliness, from fear toward faith."

I absolutely love this idea of the church as a transformational journey. As we have discussed this fall, we are "Semper Reformanda": Always Reforming. None of us is "there" yet, and yet we are endowed with the gift of the Holy Spirit, who is bringing Jesus alive in us, day by day, from glory to glory.

When I think of who I want to be (and who God desires me to become) as a follower of Jesus, one of the first words that comes to mind is: GRATEFUL. And to stay on the theme of journey, I hope the Spirit of God is moving me *towards* a spirit of gratitude *from* the spirits of entitlement, insatiability, and fault-finding.

November, of course, is a great month to engage this journey towards gratitude. In the Church Calendar, the month begins with gratitude to God "for all the saints," and by the end of the month, we are celebrating Thanksgiving.

None of our lives are perfect. All of us have problems and struggles. But that is not the point of gratitude. If we wait for everything to be perfect and in order to give thanks, we will surely miss out on gratitude. Our gratitude is not based on the perfection of our lives, but the goodness and glory of God, the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and the assurance of the Holy Spirit that all things are being made new.

We all have our "things to be thankful for" lists—many of which are filled with people and possessions specific to us, and things that come and go. I urge you to root your practice of gratitude this month in the deep and fertile soil of the unchanging God and the sure Good News of Jesus.


